



## MAINTENANCE



### Pump

1. Wash hands and place gloves on hand.
2. Place pump, hose on decontamination table or counter.
3. Spray with disinfectant. Do not use phenol based disinfectants.
4. Wipe down pump and hose
5. Let pump and hose dry for approximately 15 minutes.

### Mattress

1. Wash hands and use gloves.
2. Place mattress on decontamination table or counter.
3. Spray with a Quaternary disinfectant. Do not use phenol based disinfectants.
4. Wipe down top of mattress with towel and let sit for approximately 15 minutes.
5. Turn mattress over and repeat the cleaning process.
6. Let the mattress hang dry in a well-ventilated area between 12 - 24 hours.
7. Covers can be removed and washed in a gentle cycle using disinfectants.
8. Put in dryer only in spin cycle to remove excess moisture, do not use heat.



## TROUBLESHOOTING

Mattress Not Inflating	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. No Power</li> <li>2. CPR Valve opened</li> <li>3. Air Rail or Hoses Kinked</li> <li>4. Hose not connected to pump</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Check plug in outlet, check fuse</li> <li>2. Twist to close position</li> <li>3. Check that hoses are not impeded by bed rail or other obstruction</li> </ol>
Power Failure	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Power Surge</li> <li>2. Blown fuse</li> <li>3. Power cord is not plugged in</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Turn power switch off then on</li> <li>2. Change fuse</li> <li>3. Plug power cord into outlet</li> </ol>
Pump Not Inflating	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Pump in standby mode</li> <li>2. Not responding to mode</li> <li>3. Filter is dirty</li> <li>4. Excess Noise</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Press operate button, select auto firm, or alternate mode.</li> <li>2. Turn Power switch on then off to reset.</li> <li>3. Remove filter located under the carry handle of pump. Vacuum or rinse under water to remove excess dust.</li> <li>4. Return for authorized technical service.</li> </ol>

## MAINTENANCE



### Pump

1. Wash hands and place gloves on hand.
2. Place pump, hose on decontamination table or counter.
3. Spray with disinfectant. Do not use phenol based disinfectants.
4. Wipe down pump and hose
5. Let pump and hose dry for approximately 15 minutes.

### Mattress

1. Wash hands and place gloves on hand.
2. Place mattress on decontamination table or counter.
3. Spray with Madacide or other disinfectants. Do not use phenol based disinfectants.
4. Wipe down top of mattress with paper towel and let sit for approximately 15 minutes.
5. Turn mattress over and repeat the cleaning process.
6. Let the mattress hang dry in a well-ventilated area between 12 - 24 hours.
7. Covers can be removed and washed in a gentle cycle using disinfectants.
8. Put in dryer only in spin cycle to remove excess moisture, do not use heat.



## TROUBLESHOOTING
